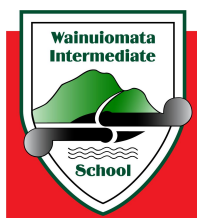

WIS OPEN EVENING Wednesday 28 August 2019

Dear Parents and Guardians

We will be holding our annual **Year 6 Open Evening** from 6pm-7.30pm on Wednesday 28 August.

The main purpose of the Open Evening is to provide an opportunity for Year 6 students and their parents/whanau from our contributing schools to visit and see our '**school in action**'. Visitors will be able to observe our students and teachers involved in a range of teaching and learning activities. Parents of students already attending Intermediate are also welcome to attend.

We are inviting our students to return to school in **full uniform** and report to their class rooms by **5.45pm** for roll call and preparation for the arrival of visitors from 6pm onwards. Lessons start at 6pm.

Bus transport to and from the Intermediate will be provided, free of charge, along the normal school bus route picking up and dropping off **at the regular bus stops**. It is very important that we know how many students will be travelling by bus to allow us to make the necessary arrangements. **They will be given a bus pass from school to show the driver if they will be catching the bus.**

Bus Route: At 4.50pm, bus leaves from top of Hine Road, and goes via Wainuiomata Village, Main Road, Wainuiomata Road, Wellington Road and goes via Norfolk Street, Wise Street, Nelson Crescent and Parkway Extension to WIS.

Although attendance to the Open Evening is not compulsory, we hope that those students who are invited to attend will be allowed to do so by their parents.

Students who do attend the Open Evening, with parental permission, will be dismissed from school at **12.30pm on Friday 30 August**.

Students who do not attend the Open Evening or do not have parent permission to finish early on Friday, will be dismissed from school at the usual time of **2.45pm on Friday 30 August**.

It is essential that the attached **permission form** is completed by parents and returned to school by **Monday 26 August**.

All forms must be returned to classroom teachers, regardless of whether the student is attending the Open Evening or not.

The format for the evening is

- 5.45pm All invited students arrive at school in full school uniform.
Students report to own classrooms for roll call.
Students doing Technocraft will go to Technocraft Rooms after Roll Call.
Student leaders will report to the Hall at 5.45pm for Roll Call.
- 6pm Open Evening begins with Kapa Haka performance in the hall. Visitors meet in School Hall before being shown around the school in small groups by student leaders.
- 7.15pm Students dismissed from class to catch the bus home. Bus departs at 7:20pm.
- The rest of the students can be collected by parents from the School Hall by 7:30pm.
